After a move to Oregon, Terri & her family moved to Australia in the late 70s where she studied ceramics at Perth Tech. A job offer for her husband brought them to Adelaide where Terri continued her art interests both here and interstate.

"Being an avid reader and traveller on three continents has been a wonderful life, great with following the ceramic cultures and art practices, languages and friendships of the many people whose paths I have crossed. Sharing a meal with friends using the pottery I have made gives me great pleasure."
