Anita was a primary and high school art educator in Canada for 15 years before moving to Australia. Since settling in Adelaide, she has spent her time creating in different media.



She was greatly influenced by one of her own teachers, who provided a broad experience in visual art, and as a result, she still loves and works in a variety of styles and media. Her art involves painting, printmaking, mixed media and photography. She finds inspiration in nature as well as in her travels. Natural found materials such as feathers and leaves are sometimes incorporated into the artwork. She is most drawn to the aspects of experimentation and exploration in the creative process.

In the past couple of years, she has also started jewellery making. It took months to develop the first piece, and from it, the whole process has evolved into what it is today - earthy and modern jewellery designs. Making each item individually is the result of merging creative thoughts with various physical processes. Some of her leather pendants are first painted or printed with a pattern, hand cut and then assembled to form the final product.

From handmade greeting cards, art, and jewellery, you will see a variety of Anita's creations in the gallery shop.
