Jennie Yann Goh, a Malaysian born artist, was educated at the Tasmanian and South Australian Schools of Art. After graduating, she worked as a Commercial Artist/Graphic Designer and, from 1990, jointly managed a successful graphic design studio for 10 years.



Influenced by her travels through Singapore, Thailand, Malaysia, India, China, Japan and recently Europe, her artwork reflects her technical training and background as a graphic artist, her spiritual yearnings and her understanding of different cultures and philosophies. She often incorporates mixed media, collage, found objects and drawing in her work.

Jennie is a Fellow of the Royal South Australian Society of Arts (RSASA) & exhibits regularly at the RSASA Gallery, Gallery M, and other community and group exhibitions. She was also a finalist of the Inaugural 2010 Solar Art Prize. In 2011, she participated in a successful group exhibition "The Languages of Poetry" at the Nexus Multicultural Arts Centre, North Terrace, Adelaide, with three other artists of different cultural backgrounds - Marie-Claire Ralph, Shahin Azadegan & the late Ian Willding.

She is the Art Consultant for the Graham F Smith Peace Foundation Annual fund-raising Art Auction. The Foundation promotes peace through all forms of art that relate to human rights, social justice and environmental sustainability. To achieve its purpose, the foundation has a series of programs including an annual major grant of \$10,000 to an artist or an art organization.

Jennie is also a member of the Gallery M Exhibition Committee since the late 1990's.
