Kate Foster - Print Maker

Joined June 2016

I began my journey into printmaking at the North Adelaide School of Art and my past work has included etching, silk screen, mono prints and linocuts.

I enjoy the physical act of carving the lino, using the tools in a variety of ways to incorporate a sculptural feel which contributes to the graphic qualities of the final print. For many years I worked in digital print and find combining the digital process with the hands on process of carving both challenging and engaging.

The artwork is drawn onto the lino in reverse which is something that takes time and experience to master. Cut areas appear as white and solid areas print as black. To print multiple colours using the reduction method, each colour is printed as a separate run on the press. The printed outcome can produce unexpected and often stunning works on paper.

Suburban landscape is my inspiration. It's the small things — magpies in my local park, native plants in my garden and older houses, once familiar in neighbouring streets, disappearing to make way for new development.

Printmaking offers me a way of combining my love of drawing and design. With each completed work I realise there is always more to learn. For me, it is a journey of discovery and experimentation which ends in the excitement of bringing my prints to life.
