Kaurna: Still Here

A HALF GALLERY EXHIBITION OF TRADITIONAL CULTURAL ARTIFACTS RECREATED BY PETER TURNER & CLEM NEWCHURCH

Artists Peter Turner and Clem Newchurch present their exhibition Kaurna - Still Here. Developed as part of the Guildhouse First Nations Collection Project, presented in collaboration with the South Australian Museum.

Inspired by the George French Angas collection of 1880's illustrations of botanicals, First Nations people, and the south-eastern coastal landscape of South Australia, Clem and Peter researched and responded to the Museum's collection to create a new body of work. Drawing on their deep connection to the landscapes depicted in the images and their own research into their Ancestor's practice, Clem and Peter have recreated over 70 traditional objects similar to those used before European colonisation.

The City of Marion is presenting the exhibition at Gallery M to celebrate and showcase First Nations artists as part of Reconciliation Week. Gallery M is proud to be the first gallery outside the Museum to exhibit this important work.
